Production area:	S. Giovanni al Natisone - Manzano Controlled Appellation of Origin-Eastern Friulian Hills
Vineyard:	la Duline and Ronco Pitotti
Grape variety:	Istrian Malvasia 60% and Sauvignon 40%
Plant placement year:	1977/1984
Breed/Rear:	One side sylvoz and guyot; meadow vineyard cultivated without irrigation nor manure, pollard assistance or bunches thinning. The very excellent productive growing equilibrium has never required thinning out bunches.
Soil:	limestone/pebbly (malvasia) Clayey-limestone marl (sauvignon)
Grapes production:	1 – 0.7 kg.
Grape harvest:	Manual, into boxes by the end of September
Wine-making:	Done in the absence of sulphur dioxide; maceration on peels before fermentation at room temperature; soft press; cool settling; alcoholic and malic-lactic fermentation, entirely carried out, in barrique; permanence on yeasts up to assembling in July 2006
Bottling:	On the 23th of July of 2007, 1700 bottles have been bottled without sterile filtration
Put on the market:	After 8 months of bottled refinement
Alcohol by volume:	14,0%
Taste impressions:	The Morus Alba represents the personal pursuit white wine. It is a blend of Malvasia and Sauvignon, refined in barrique. Wonderful with oysters and sea carpaccio
